Pastoral Position

Functional Area of Responsibility: Worship

Summary:

This is a pastoral role within the College View Church (CVC) in Lincoln, Nebrask (https://www.collegeviewchurch.org/)

The Worship Pastor is a member of the CVC Pastoral team and is responsible to:

- 1. Function in all regular capacities as an associate pastor: engage in bible studies, personal evangelism, counseling, preaching, teaching and visitation.
- 2. Plan and execute the weekly worship service(s).
- 3. In coordination with the lead pastor, coordinate all aspects of the worship ministry to function together cohesively, overseeing:
 - Song and choral selection.
 - Media preparation and presentation.
 - Sound and lighting enhancements.
 - Coordination of all instrumentalists, vocalists, and other participants.
 - Development and scheduling of teams of instrumentalists and vocalists.
 - Organization and leadership of practice sessions.
- 4. Assume pastoral and discipleship care of the worship teams.
- 5. Manage volunteer schedules for worship teams, computer, sound and video.
- 6. Assist in developing worship ministries for student and children ministries, including CVC, College View Academy, Union Adventist University and The Well, CVC's young adult ministry. This would include leading worship for student ministries and events.
- 7. Assist to develop student talent and leadership, serving as a resource and assisting in children's music and worship (VBS, special events, etc.)
- 8. Lead in coordination and development of CVC choir and instrumental music and provide regular opportunities for them to participate during weekly worship and special events.
- 9. Develop and manage the music budget in consultation with the pastoral staff.
- 10. Lead and maintain a digital media production ministry, especially focused on music and worship videos for purposes of evangelism and to facilitate the growth of the "CVC Worship" brand.
- 11. Coordinate special musical events and original productions as opportunities for engagement with CVC members, visitors, and our local community.

- 12. When possible, engage in the production of original music.
- 13. Lead a regular worship committee to help coordinate weekly worship service and special events.
- 14. Maintain communication with UAU and its music department to help coordinate regular incorporation in the CVC worship services and special events.

Minimum Qualifications

Required:

- The pastor must be a believer in Christ, the Bible, and the power of prayer.
 Enthusiastically support the vision and philosophy of the ministry of the Seventh-day Adventist church and attend worship service regularly. The pastor will stay spiritually sensitive to the Holy Spirit through a consistent prayer life and personal Bible study or accountability group. They will lead people by example of life in the Spirit and service of the Lord.
- Must have 5+ years experience in ministry, or in a ministerial position, or a degree in a related field.
- Must possess a Master's degree or be willing to pursue a Master's in a related ministry area.
- Must remain current in all aspects of the Worship Ministry. This includes showing an interest in participating in Christian worship educational programs, conferences, and training as approved and funded by the church/conference.
- Be a team player that is trustworthy, displays a positive attitude and will loyally support the other members of the church staff.
